As you may be aware, The Royal British Legion are leading a national movement to say 'Thank You' to all who served, sacrificed and changed our world during the First World War. On Friday 9th November, the whole school is engaging in a Day of Remembrance.

We will begin our day with Collective Worship, then the children will participate in an art focused day linked to the theme.

During the day, we will be attempting to create a human poppy as a sign of Remembrance. We ask that all children in **Years R, 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 wear as much red as possible** and that children in **Year 6 wear as much black as possible**. There is no charge for this, although you may want to make a donation to the Poppy Appeal.
